

Behaviour Policy

At Avenues College we believe that all staff, students and visitors have the right to a safe, inclusive and supportive learning environment. We foster positive relationships and partnerships that complement our College values of *Courage, Creativity, Resilience and Respect*.

“As an Avenues College student, I acknowledge it is my responsibility to ensure my actions and behaviours do not impact negatively on the school and others.”

College Rules:

Avenues College rules are in place to provide staff, students and visitors with a safe, positive and welcoming environment allowing people to learn and grow together.

If these rules are not respected, consistent consequences will be applied.

Respect for yourself

- Wear the correct Avenues College uniform each day.
- Be well groomed at all times.
- Smoking and/or having cigarettes is not permitted during college hours, to and from college and when wearing the College uniform.
- Alcohol is not permitted under any circumstances.
- Illegal Drugs are not tolerated, SAPOL will be involved.

Respect the rights of others

- Show courtesy and politeness and be considerate to staff, fellow students and visitors to the College.
- Do not do anything that may cause injury and hurt to others.
- Do not fight or cause fights with behaviours such as teasing, taunting, spreading rumours, bullying, harassment and using abusive language.
- Do not bring to the College and use aerosol deodorant cans as they pose a threat to people’s health.

Respect the rights of teachers to teach and students to learn

- Be prepared to learn by attending all your lessons on time and bringing all appropriate equipment you need for that lesson.
- Respect the desire of others to learn without your behaviour disrupting their learning.
- Submit all assignments by their deadlines.
- Negotiate an extension at least 48 hours before the due deadline with your teacher.
- Complete all homework and other tasks set by your teachers.
- Follow instructions given by all staff members without arguing.

Respect your property and that of the College and others

- Always look after your personal property.
- Do not take or steal property that does not belong to you.
- Look after your college: Do not vandalise or cause graffiti damage to buildings/grounds, furniture or books.
- Do not litter: Use the bins supplied to dispose of your waste.

Attendance

- Be on time, remain on college grounds during college hours (unless other college sanctioned arrangements have been made)
- Attend all your scheduled lessons, study periods and activities.
